Work casual hours around your uni or trade timetable as a Cadet. Get early exposure to commercial projects, apply your technical learning in real settings, and be mentored by industry pros.


Graduate Program








What's been the most valuable advice or lesson you've received from a mentor here?


Never be afraid to make mistakes, but I have to own it and correct it.

How did you feel when you first joined BowdenCorp — and what surprised you most about the experience?

I felt very welcomed by everyone here, regardless of the department, from estimating to the accounts team. Everyone at one point or another would come up to speak to me and at times check in to see how I am going. As I fall under the project delivery section, the entire team all reached out to see if there was any help they could provide, whether it be finding alternate trades or help with the software/processes here. 
Eligibility Criteria

- 2. If short-listed, you will be invited to a first round interview with our team
- 3. If successful with your first interview, you will be invited to meet with some of the team for a final interview
- 4. We will conduct reference checks and an offer will be made to the successful candidates. For cadets this offer is usually for a casual role, and for graduates usually a two year contract, with the opportunity of permanent employment at the end of the Trainee Program.
